Statim-Yaga* is a range of services and programs we deliver to maximise employment and training outcomes for Indigenous Australians in the construction industry.

At the end of the program participants receive a Certificate I in Construction along with skills and experience within the Construction Industry.

PROGRAM OUTLINE

Participants will complete an accredited construction training, a Personal Development Program and gain on-site experience, all within a fully operational construction environment over 12 weeks.

The program is delivered around real construction projects to give participants a better understanding of the industry and a taster of the variety of different trades, such as:

- Carpentry
- Painting
- Tiling
- Working with cranes and hoists
- Scaffolding and more

With this direct exposure individuals can make better informed decisions about their careers.
